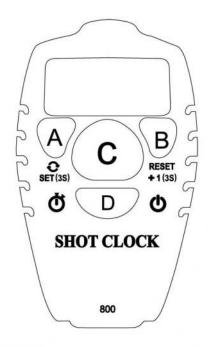
INSTRUCTION



FEATURES

- 1.Records possession time.
- Counts down from preset time between 0 and 99 seconds.
- Switches between two instantly resettable preset times.
- Restarts & Resets without stopping the countdown.
- 5. Shot clock rectification & violation.
- 6.Ideal for time-limited games or events.

TO SET THE SHOT CLOCK

- 1.Remove battery insulation film first.
- 2.Hold A button 3 seconds and the first 2 digits (1st timer) will flash.
 - a Press C button to increase the number or hold for rapid advance.
 - b Press D button to decrease the number or hold for rapid advance.
- 3. While the digits are still flashing, press A button and the last 2 digits (2nd timer) will flash.
 - a.Press C button to increase the number or hold for rapid advance.
 - b.Press D button to decrease the number or hold for rapid advance.
- 4.Press A button to complete the setting and the first timer will appear on the display.

HOW TO OPERATE

- * When the display shows the first timer:
- Press C button to start/stop the countdown on the first timer.

- 2.Press A button to restart (2) the timer.
- 3. Press B button to reset to the original setting.
- 4.Press D button to switch to the second timer and start the countdown.
- * When the display shows the second timer:
- Press D button to start/stop the countdown on the second timer.
- 2.Press A button to restart (♦) the countdown.
- 3. Press B button to reset to the original setting.
- 4.Press C button to switch to the first timer and start the countdown.

RECTIFICATION

- To correct the shot clock, the countdown shall be stopped first.
- 2.Hold B button 3 seconds and the digits will start to go back up incrementally.

VIOLATION

- 1. When the possession time reaches zero, the alarm will go off and last for 3 seconds.
- 2. The display will return to the first preset time.

U POWER ON/OFF

- Hold D button 3 seconds to power OFF the display.
- 2. The display will blank when no activity has been detected for 2 hours.
- 3. Press any button to power ON the unit.

$((\bullet))$

- * Hold C button 3 seconds to turn the beep sounds on/off.
 - (((●)) symbol appears/disappears)

BATTERY REPLACEMENT

- Remove the battery cover on the back side of the body with a coin or similar tool, using the arrows as direction indicators.
- Remove and replace the battery with type LR44 or equivalent.
- 3.Be sure that " + " side is up.
- Replace the battery cover and lock into place.
